



List the following information:

1. The attributes of the User entity: UserID, CoachID, Name and HabitNum
2. The primary and foreign keys of the Comments entity. For each of the foreign keys identify the entity and item they reference: The primary key of the comments entity is the UniqueID and the foreign keys are HabitCheckinID which references the Checkin entity and the HabitCheckinID item in that entity, UserID which references the entity Users and the UserID item in that entity, and the CoachID which references the Coaches entity and the CoachID item in that entity.
3. The type and cardinality of the Users-Coach relationship: The relationship is a one to many relationship and the cardinality is that a coach *can* have many users while a user *can* only have one coach.
4. The type and cardinality of the Users-Habit relationship: The relationship is a many to many relationship while the cardinality is such that a user *can* have many habits while a habit *must* have at least one user.
- 5, The primary key for the Coach relation/table: The primary key is CoachID
